## PRAYER DIARY

### **Rohingya refugee crisis, Myanmar**

Conflict between the government military and Rohingya has effectively tipped into 'ethnic cleansing' resulting in the most rapidly growing humanitarian crisis of late: in recent months over half a million Rohingya have fled into Bangladesh, a country already beset by major problems of poverty and flooding. Please pray for: an end to the violence, a generous international humanitarian response, effective treatment of consequent diseases and that Christian organisations will play their part in the relief effort and manage to reach this largely Muslim minority with the gospel.

Last week Jo Stevenson launched the shoebox appeal.
