PRAYER DIARY

Philippines Tsunami

The tsunami triggered by the earthquake has resulted in over 1,400 deaths in the Palu area – construction of homes on silt and an inadequately maintained early warning system has added to the devastation. Please pray for God to console the victims' families, for the Government to help those affected as best it can, many of whom now lack access to food, fresh water and basic services, for a generous, well co-ordinated international aid response to boost relief efforts and for lessons to be learnt in how to minimise the effects of tsunamis in future.

Over the weekend of 11th -15th October, Jonathan, Will & Alison, Darren and Sarah will be visiting Adrian Bretan and his family in Satu Mare, Romania. Adrian, who has recently moved back to Romania from Warrington, is one of our mission partners and is now a pastor to churches around Satu Mare.
