



Living in Submission

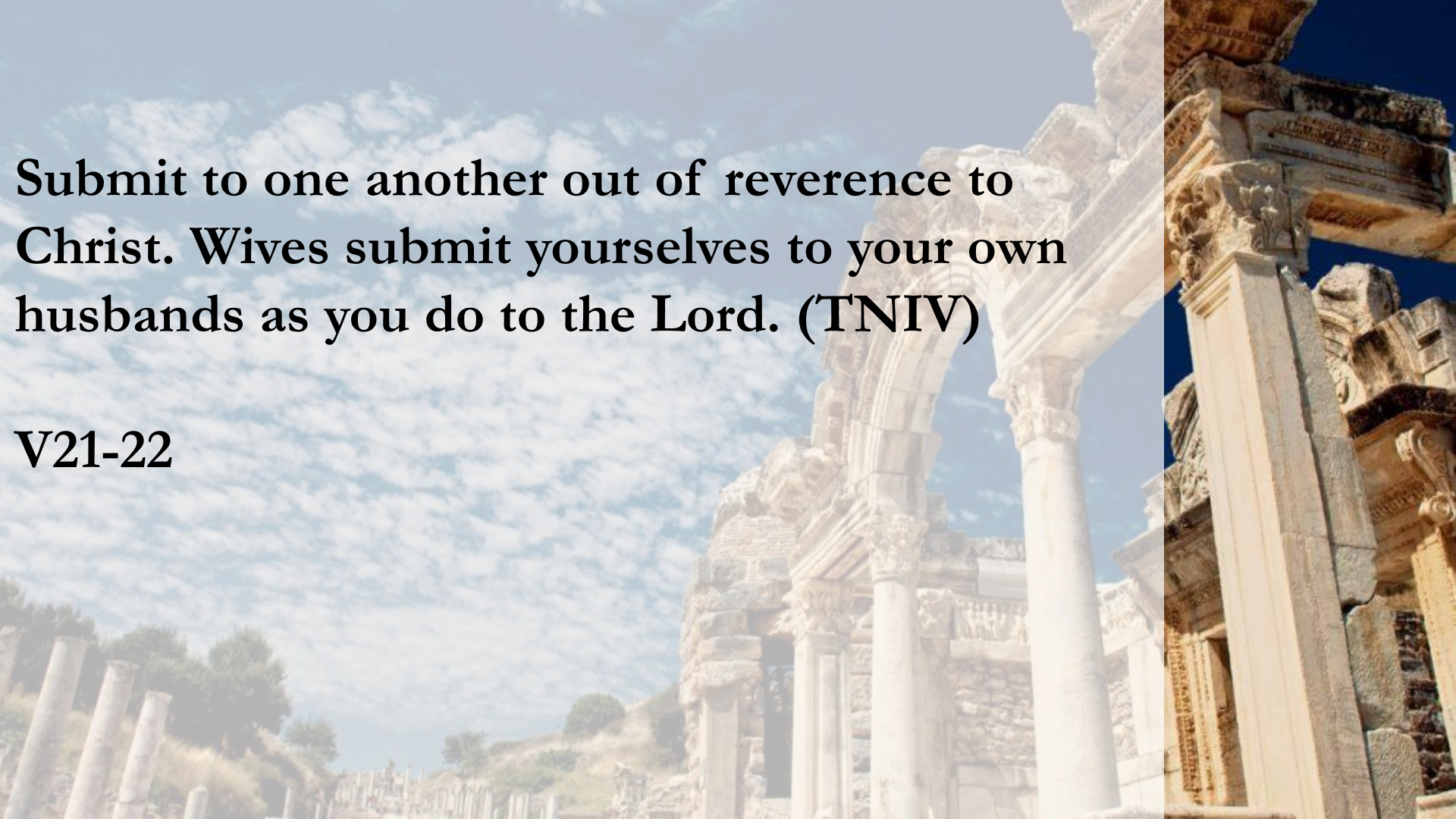
