## JESUS BIGS UP JOHN... BIG TIME....

**Matthew 11:7-14** <sup>7</sup>As John's disciples were leaving, Jesus began to speak to the crowd about John: "What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed swayed by the wind? <sup>8</sup>If not, what did you go out to see? A man dressed in fine clothes? No, those who wear fine clothes are in kings' palaces. <sup>9</sup>Then what did you go out to see? A prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. <sup>10</sup>This is the one about whom it is written: "'I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way before you.'" <sup>11</sup>Truly I tell you, among those born of women there has not risen anyone greater than John the Baptist; yet whoever is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. <sup>12</sup>From the days of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been subjected to violence, and violent people have been raiding it. <sup>13</sup>For all the Prophets and the Law prophesied until John. <sup>14</sup>And if you are willing to accept it, he is the Elijah who was to come'.



# THE WORD IS OUR FINAL AUTHORITY/ HOPE/PURPOSE & IDENTITY.

Let's look at Matthew 11:4. Great, now look at Isaiah 35:5 – 6a;

'Eyes of the blind will be opened and the ears of the deaf will be unstopped. The lame will leap like a deer and the mute tongue shout for joy'.

Let's just admit it, John did not need an emotional boost in the dungeon. He didn't need goosebumps or a feel good moment.
