

Jesus, the Ten Lepers & a Thankful heart Luke 17:11-19



Leviticus 13:46

As long as they have the disease, they remain unclean. They must live alone; they must live outside the camp.



▶ Leviticus 13:45

▶ Anyone with such a defiling disease must wear torn clothes, let their hair be unkempt, cover the lower part of their face and cry out, 'Unclean! Unclean!'



▶ Luke 17:16

▶ He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.



▶ Luke 17:14

▶ When he saw them, he said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed.

- ▶ Leviticus 14
 - ▶ It was compulsory that Lepers show themselves to the Priests if they had been cleansed.



▶ James 2:17

▶ In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.



▶ Hebrews 11:4

▶ By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead.

▶ Hebrews 11:8

▶ By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going.



▶ Luke 17:15-16

▶ One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

▶ **Mark 16:15**

▶ **Acts 1:8**

▶ **Deuteronomy 8:10**
