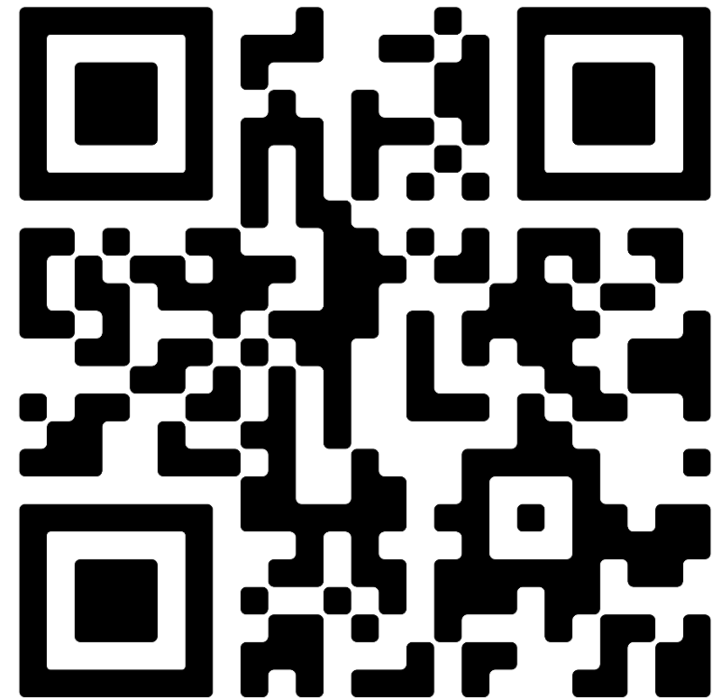

- "Irenaeus sometime in 2nd century (Adv. Haer. 1. v. c. 6, § 1) speaks of "many brethren" whom he heard in the church having the gift of prophecy and of speaking in "diverse tongues", bringing the hidden things of men to light and expounding the mysteries of God.

The Gift of Tongues

1 Corinthians 14:22

Tongues, then, are a sign, not for believers but for unbelievers; prophecy, however, is not for unbelievers but for believers.
