There are many things that are still unexplainable by current scientific understanding. There are certainly many things that we don't and will never understand about God!

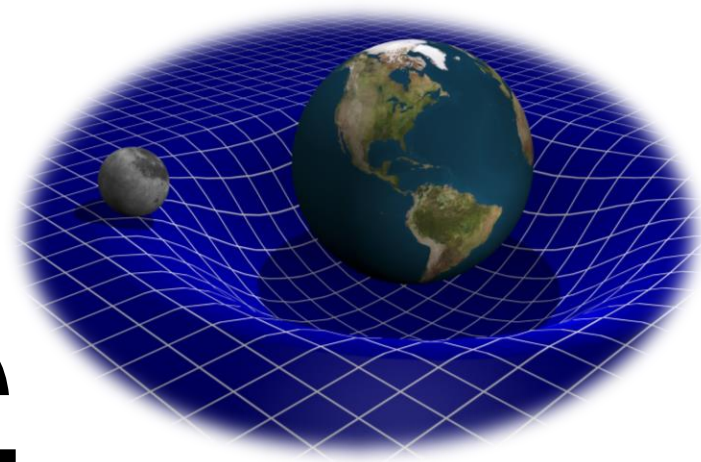


What is light?

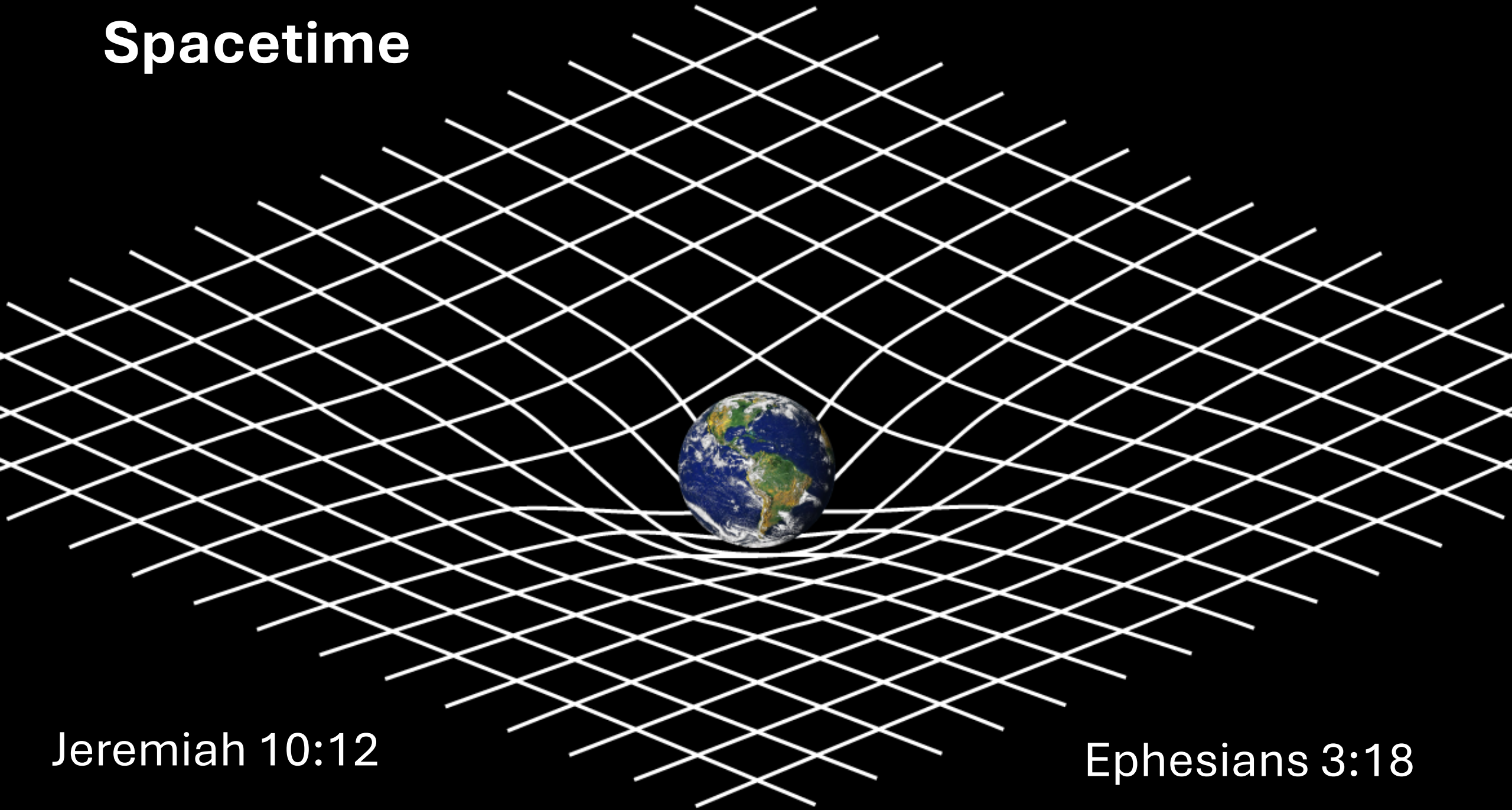
