Fellowship =

Companionship: A warm and friendly bond.

Shared interests: A group joined by common goals or beliefs.

Christian Fellowship =

**A direct spiritual connection with God
the Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy
Spirit.**

**A deep, active sharing and
partnership in a common life, faith,
and purpose.**
